- ➤ Districts and Lodges that want to sell raffle tickets in the Convention Center during the Conference must contact our Lodge Secretary, Patty Tackett, at 937-333-7109 <u>no later than July 1st</u> in order to have a table reserved.
- The host **Crowne Plaza Hotel** is nearly booked full. There are still a limited number of rooms with single beds available at the host hotel. The overflow hotel is the DoubleTree where a block of rooms is being held for Conference delegates, but only *until July 1st*. After that date, the held rooms will be made available to the general public.
- A reminder that the annual **FOP Awards Banquet**, usually held on Monday night, will be held on <u>Sunday</u> night, July 23rd at the Crowne Plaza Hotel (the host hotel) and the **Hospitality Barbeque**, usually held on Sunday night, will be held on <u>Monday</u>, July 24th at Dave Hall Plaza next to the Crowne Plaza Hotel.
- A reminder that there will be a one-time \$10 cover charge to gain entrance to the hospitality tent for anyone who has not registered for either of two major Events (Banquet-Barbeque). Registration closes at 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, Sunday and Monday.
- Riverscape is an open venue to the membership during the week. There will be a *Laser Light Show* on the river after the Dayton Dragons ball game Monday night.
